EVENT PURPOSE: The 1-2-3 = ABC Community Event: in 1, day, 20 blocks in Downtown Dover will receive over 300 hours of volunteer service resulting in A Beautiful Community.

- 5) Re-start Neighborhood Revitalization in the 20-block target area
